Reach Up (Worship):

First Impressions

Tech Team

- Be an unnoticed and yet essential part of our worship services.
- Learn what all sorts of buttons, knobs and switches really do.

Ushers & Servers

- Help create a seamless worship service for everyone.

Bands

- Use your musical talents to serve as lead worshippers for the congregation.



Reach In (Discipleship):

To help individuals grow beyond who they are into who God wants them to be.

Connection Group Leader

- Provide a first step to help individuals connect to Jesus and one another.

Care Group Leader

- Provide a safe environment for individuals to deal with some of life's difficulties.

Elective Teacher/Facilitator

- Help others take the next step in their faith journey by leading an elective.

Involvement

- Help individuals identify their spiritual gifts and grow in their faith by partnering with CCJ in ministry.



Reach Out (Outreach):

To make an impact both locally and globally for the Kingdom of Jesus.

Global Missions

- To involve CCJ in Kingdom missions around the world.
- Maintain communication with missionaries that CCJ supports.

Local Missions

- Lead CCJ in making a difference for the Kingdom of Jesus in our community.

Outreach

- Develop opportunities for CCJ to impress upon people that they matter to God.

Counseling Services

- To walk alongside individuals, couples and families as they deal with the difficult issues of life.

Benevolence

- Oversee the distribution of CCJ funds as we help meet the physical needs of local individuals.



The Spring (Children's Ministry):

Help to forge and foster a lifelong love for Jesus in children.

Greeters

- Provide clarity and assurance for guests as you help them check their children into the appropriate areas.

Check-In Assistant

- Ensure all children are securely checked in and accounted for. Our children's safety is of the highest priority.

Small Group Leader

- Build relationships with students, help them focus during teach time and worship, and then recap the lesson with them afterwards.

Room Leader

- Help guide the Small Group Leaders in each room, be the point person in emergencies and keep your room on schedule.

Community Leader

- Lead and guide all Room Leaders for a particular service. Help ensure these leaders have all they need to succeed.

Wednesday Night Leader

- Connect with the same group of children each week as you lead them through bible study.

Teacher/Drama

- Act in the drama/teach time that will help teach the students Bible lessons.

Host

- Introduce the topic from the stage, keep things rolling and lead actions for the children during worship time.



The Well (Teen Ministry):

Help to forge and foster a lifelong love for Jesus in teens.

Volunteer Leader

- Be the hands and feet to make sure teen ministry events happen.

Small Group Leader

- Connect with high school teens by facilitating a small group.

Bible Study Leader

- Build relationships with middle-school teens by helping them understand how the Bible applies to their lives.

Servant Team Leader

- Connect with and lead student leaders.



Support Teams:

to support other CCJ teams succeed in their specific ministries.

Health Ministries

- To provide general health guidance to the congregation.
- Respond in case of a specific medical need on site or at a CCJ-sponsored event.

Property Team

- Ensure that the facilities and site God has entrusted to CCJ are well cared for, and provide a good first impression for our guests.

Risk Management

- Be prepared for unexpected and undesirable events, should they ever occur.

Stewardship Team

- Ensure the monies God has entrusted to CCJ are managed responsibly.

S.O.S. (Seniors offering services)

- Connect with other seniors in a variety of outreach and discipleship opportunities to partner with CCJ in ministry.
